

SYC Security Role Description



Job title: Security Volunteer

Reporting to: Volunteer Leader

Hours: Typically, 11pm - Morning (this is often done in shifts or key site walkthroughs throughout the night)

Location: Across the full State Youth Camp Site

About the Role: One key aspect of overnight duties for State Youth Camp is helping to maintain security and minimise risk while campers should remain within their tribe's campsite area. A key part of this role is understanding the relationship between rule enforcement and the role of the local church/youth group. We should always seek to redirect youth to their local leaders and only where imminent danger is present, to step in.

Key Responsibilities

SYC Security Role Description

Duties of the role	Time spent	Description
Night Patrols	90%	Conduct site walk throughs, staying alert for campers outside their tribe areas or any security risks. This includes ensuring no prohibited items are in use, no campers are sleeping in their car or other predetermined security risks. All training will be provided.
Rubbish Collection	10%	Whilst conducting security walk throughs, please be mindful of any overflowing or full garbage and clean as appropriate.

Work experience and skills

Willingness to work late/overnight is a key part of this role. We also acknowledge the general darkness experienced on site during this time and ask that any security volunteers consider their level of comfort when assigned to work during these hours.
